

Dear Catechists/Teachers,

This is a commissioning service to assist children and youth to understand that as members of the Holy Childhood Association they are making a commitment (or, promise) to:

- Pray for
- Learn about and
- Contribute financially to children in developing countries.

Preparation:

- 1. Spend one or two religion periods talking about and discussing the word (and the concept of) mission. Lead the children to understand that by our Baptism we are all missionaries. The whole Church is missionary.
- 2. Show a video about children in developing countries. The HCA has its video catalogue online. Visit www.missionsocieties.ca and follow the links to the Holy Childhood Association.
- 3. Invite the students to write their own prayers for the children of the world.
- 4. The National Office has Holy Childhood Association prayer cards available for each student free of charge. Once your class is enrolled, this could be recited as a morning or afternoon prayer. Other materials, such as a Rosary brochure and Stations of the Cross for Children, are available on our web site.
- 5. Distribute the Newsletters (if you haven't already) to each student and discuss the ideas presented. See the Catechist/Teacher Guide for additional suggestions.
- 6. Contact the National Office and order whatever number of mission boxes that are needed for your class (or school).

Immediate Preparation

- Set up the room or gym (depending on the number of students to be enrolled)
- Try to have a large world map or globe with the focus country of the HCA Newsletter clearly highlighted.
- Set up a prayer table with candles, flowers, a bible and, if possible, pictures of children around the world.
- Place the Holy Childhood Association (HCA) poster in a visible place.
- On a small side table, have the HCA enrollment (membership) cards ready.
- Choose readers for the liturgy. (This may be a Mass or a prayer celebration)

Response: The Lord hears the cry of the poor; Blessed be the Lord.

Leader: Let us pray.

All: O, Lord, Jesus, bless each of us now as we receive our Holy Childhood Association membership cards. May they remind us of our commitment to: **PRAY FOR, LEARN ABOU'T**, and **SHARE** with children and youth in other countries. Help us, Jesus, to become more like you.

Leader: The peace of the Lord is with you.

All: And also with you.

Leader: Please join in the closing singing hymn: *City of God* (or another suitable hymn).
